

ADEETIE Portal MSME Registration Guide

Introduction

The ADEETIE Portal enables MSMEs to register under the Assistance for Deployment of Energy Efficient Technologies in Industries and Establishments (ADEETIE) Scheme.

Before starting the registration process, ensure you have:

- Valid Udyam Registration Number
- Active Email Address
- Active Mobile Number

Step 1: Fill the Registration Form

Open the ADEETIE Portal Visit: <https://adeetie.eeslindia.org>.

Click on “Register” On the homepage menu bar, click the Register option. Select MSME Registration

You will be redirected to the MSME Registration for ADEETIE Portal page.

Complete all mandatory fields marked with (*).

About ADEETIE (Assistance for Deployment of Energy Efficient Technologies in Industries and Establishments) Scheme

The Ministry of Power (MoP), supported by Bureau of Energy Efficiency (BEE) has envisaged a constructive scheme (policy) enabling complete handholding services for adoption of energy efficient technologies, supported by fiscal financial incentives (interest subvention). Assistance for Deployment of Energy Efficient Technologies in Industrial Establishments (ADEETIE) Scheme has been pragmatically planned with following

Objective: To facilitate MSMEs to upgrade with energy efficient technologies/measures across 60 clusters spanning 14 sectors through financial instruments and handholding them in carrying out investment grade energy audit, detail project report, monitoring and verification of the implementation.

1. Udyam Registration Number *

Enter your registered Udyam Registration Number exactly as mentioned on your Udyam Registration Certificate.

- The portal validates the Udyam Registration Number.
- Only valid Udyam Registration Numbers are accepted.
- If the number is invalid, registration cannot proceed.

2. MSME Name *

After successful verification of the Udyam Registration Number, the MSME Name is automatically fetched from the Udyam database.

- This field is auto-populated.
- Users cannot edit this field.

3. Name of Nodal Person *

Enter the name of the authorized representative who will be the primary point of contact for all communications related to the ADEETIE Scheme.

4. Email Address *

Enter a valid and active email address. All portal communications will be sent to this email address.

5. Mobile Number *

Enter an active mobile number. OTP verification and important notifications will be sent to this number.

6. Create Password *

Create a strong password containing at least 8 characters with uppercase, lowercase, number, and special character.

7. Confirm Password *

Re-enter the same password to confirm.

8. Privacy Policy

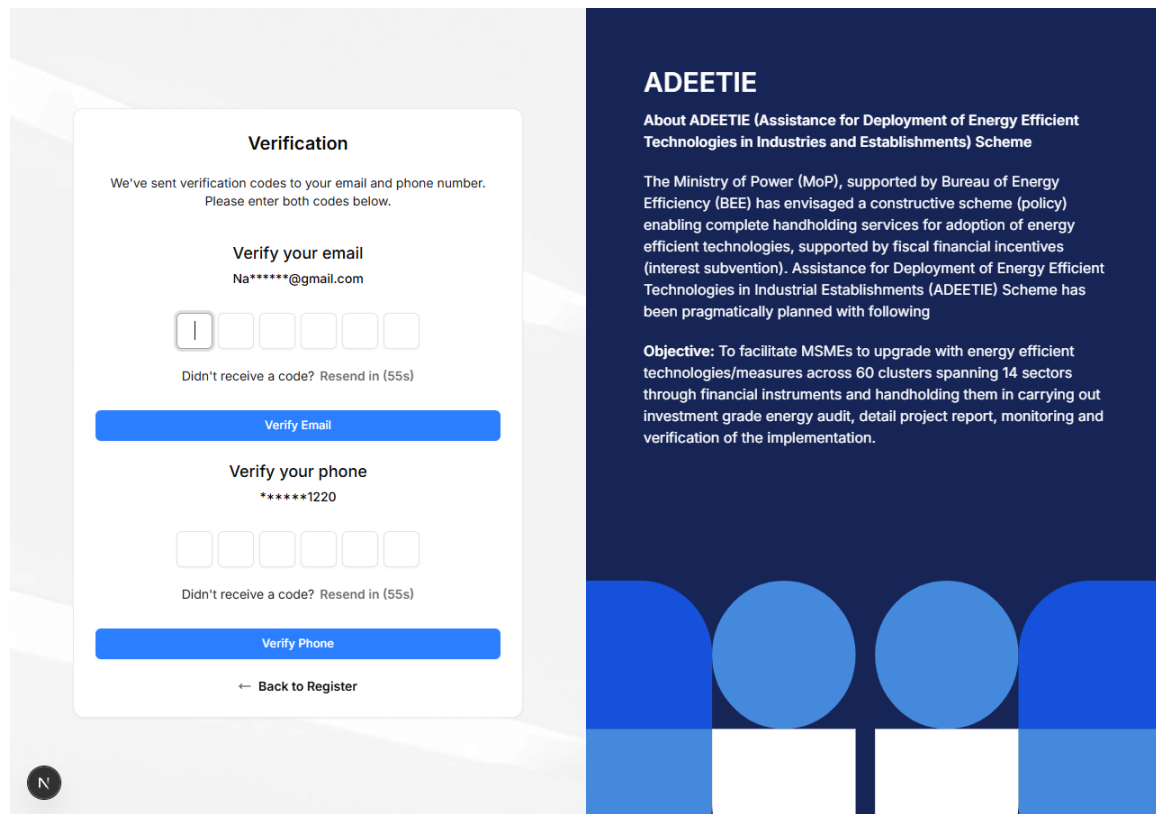
Read and accept the Privacy Policy to continue.

9. Google reCAPTCHA

Complete the 'I'm not a robot' verification before clicking Continue.

Step 2: Verify Email Address and Mobile Number

After clicking the Continue button, the portal sends separate One-Time Passwords (OTPs) to the registered email address and mobile number.

Email Verification

1. Check your registered email inbox.
2. Enter the 6-digit OTP in the 'Verify your email' section.
3. Click 'Verify Email'.

If the OTP is not received, click 'Resend' after the countdown timer expires.

Mobile Number Verification

1. Check the SMS received on your registered mobile number.
2. Enter the 6-digit OTP in the 'Verify your phone' section.
3. Click 'Verify Phone'.

If the OTP is not received, click 'Resend' after the countdown timer expires.

Important

Registration is completed only after successful verification of BOTH the registered email address and mobile number. If either verification is pending, the registration process will remain incomplete and you will not be able to proceed.

Step 3: Registration Completed

Once both OTPs have been verified successfully:

- Your MSME registration is completed.
- You can sign in to the ADEETIE Portal using your registered credentials.
- You will be redirected to the dashboard page.
